GUIDELINES FOR THE COMPETITION

EVENTS

See Entry Form for a complete listing of events. Events are offered to all ages – Tots through Adults
Age groupings will be adjusted to suit the enrollment.

RULES

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the guidelines set forth in most recent edition of the *ISI Handbook*.

JUDGES

All judges must be registered with and certified by the ISI as of January 1, 2020. Only credentialed coaches will be allowed to put skaters on the ice. All participating teams **MUST** submit a judge's form with the required number of judges based on the number of entries. This policy will be strictly enforced. **No entries will be processed until the judge's form has been received.**

VERIFICATION

The team coach must sign the entry form to verify that the information contained on the form is true and correct. The information must be accurate and complete. Inaccurate or incomplete forms will be returned. False information will result in disqualification.

ELIGIBILITY

All skaters entering the competition must be individual members of and registered with the ISI.
All entrants must be registered at their highest test level with the ISI on or before December 9, 2019.

Members of US Figure Skating, who are individual or associate members and registered with the ISI are eligible to compete in accordance with the ISI/USFSA Joint Statement of Policy. Please see rules effective September 1, 2004 regarding US Figure Skater's participation. US Figure Skating members should obtain written permission from their home club thirty (30) days prior to the competition. US Figure Skating skaters must be registered in events they wish to compete in based on their US Figure Skating test level.

AWARDS

Awards will be given for the first five places in each event. In determining the results, the winner of a division will receive 5 points for their team; 2nd place receives 4 points; 3rd place receives 3 points; 4th place receives 2 points; 5th place receives 1 point. **For Team Events – Team Compulsories, Pattern, Production, Kaleidoskate, and Synchronized Teams – the first place team receives 25 points, 2nd place – 20 points, 3rd place 15 points, 4th place – 10 points, 5th place – 5 points.** The team accumulating the most points will be declared the winner. Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams. **Percentage trophies will be awarded for the top three teams. (Teams must have a minimum of 5 skaters).**

PARTICIPATION POINTS: 1 Point for each event entry for individual, partner, and small group events and 5 points for each special group entry listed above.

MUSIC AND REGISTRATION

CDs are required. CDs are to be labeled with the skater's name, team name, event, and age. CDs must be handed in at the Registration Desk on Thursday evening January 2nd. The lead may be no longer than 6 seconds. No more than one program is to be on a CD Please have a duplicate CD with you at the arena.

Pictures, movies and videotapes may be taken for personal use only. They may not be sold, rented or otherwise used for any commercial or profit making business unless authorized in writing by the Competition Director.
